
Thank you for your past support. We will continue to honor those who we have lost to AIDS with the promise that we will remain committed to ensuring that no one faces their illness alone.




Action Wellness Client Demographics 2017

HIV Continuum of Care


THE CDC ESTIMATES THAT OF HIV-POSITIVE INDIVIDUALS IN THE U.S.:

49% are virally suppressed (<200 c/mL)


Clients engaged in Action Wellness HIV Case Management are more likely to be linked to and retained in medical care, and to achieve viral suppression.




Chronic Conditions

11% of HIV-positive clients are co-infected with Hepatitis C





Where does the money come from?


- Government Contracts = 36%
