Dear Friends.

Each year, the city of Philadelphia is faced with new challenges – as are we at Action Wellness, and so we constantly collaborate, innovate, and push ourselves to better address the needs of the community. After our rebrand from ActionAIDS in 2016, the scope of our focus has expanded beyond supporting those living with HIV to include services for people with other chronic conditions, as well as reintegration assistance for individuals recently released from the prison system. 2019 saw Action Wellness work with 3,414 unique clients and provide a range of programs for them. 
We thank those who have supported us through our history. We will always rely on your help as we keep on growing and acting as a vital resource for Philadelphians.



### HIV Continuum of Care

THE CDC\* ESTIMATES THAT OF HIV-POSITIVE INDIVIDUALS IN THE U.S. WHO KNOW THEIR STATUS:


74% were linked to medical care

58% were retained in care

53% were virally suppressed

Clients engaged in Action Wellness HIV Medical Case Management are significantly more likely to be linked to and retained in medical care, and to achieve viral suppression.\*\*





Where does the money come from?


- Pharmacy Program = 53%
